Spiritual gifts are a critical part of God's strategy for building up his church. God wants every believer to be a conduit through which his gifts can flow to others.

Each believer doing their part is how "the body grows and builds itself up in love."

We are actually commanded in Scripture to "earnestly desire" spiritual gifts. Love for God and others is to be the primary motivation for this desire for the gifts.

We cannot produce spiritual gifts but we can be responsive to the Holy Spirit who does.

What empowers the effective release and functioning of spiritual gifts?

a church culture that highly values spiritual gifts, values character even more, and embraces the honesty, tension, experimentation and messiness necessary to enable believers to mature in both Romans 12:3 ESV/SWT For by the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think with sober judgment, each according to the measure of conviction that God has assigned. literally, bitter zeal a desire to put one's self forward

James 3:14-16 ESV
