causes division

has difficulty maintaining relationships frequent quarrels, but always sees others as the problem

very selffocused, even when serving others

seem nearly incapable of letting go of an offence

commonly questions the decisions and motivations of others

deliberately undermines those in authority

others to win
them over to
their point
of view


