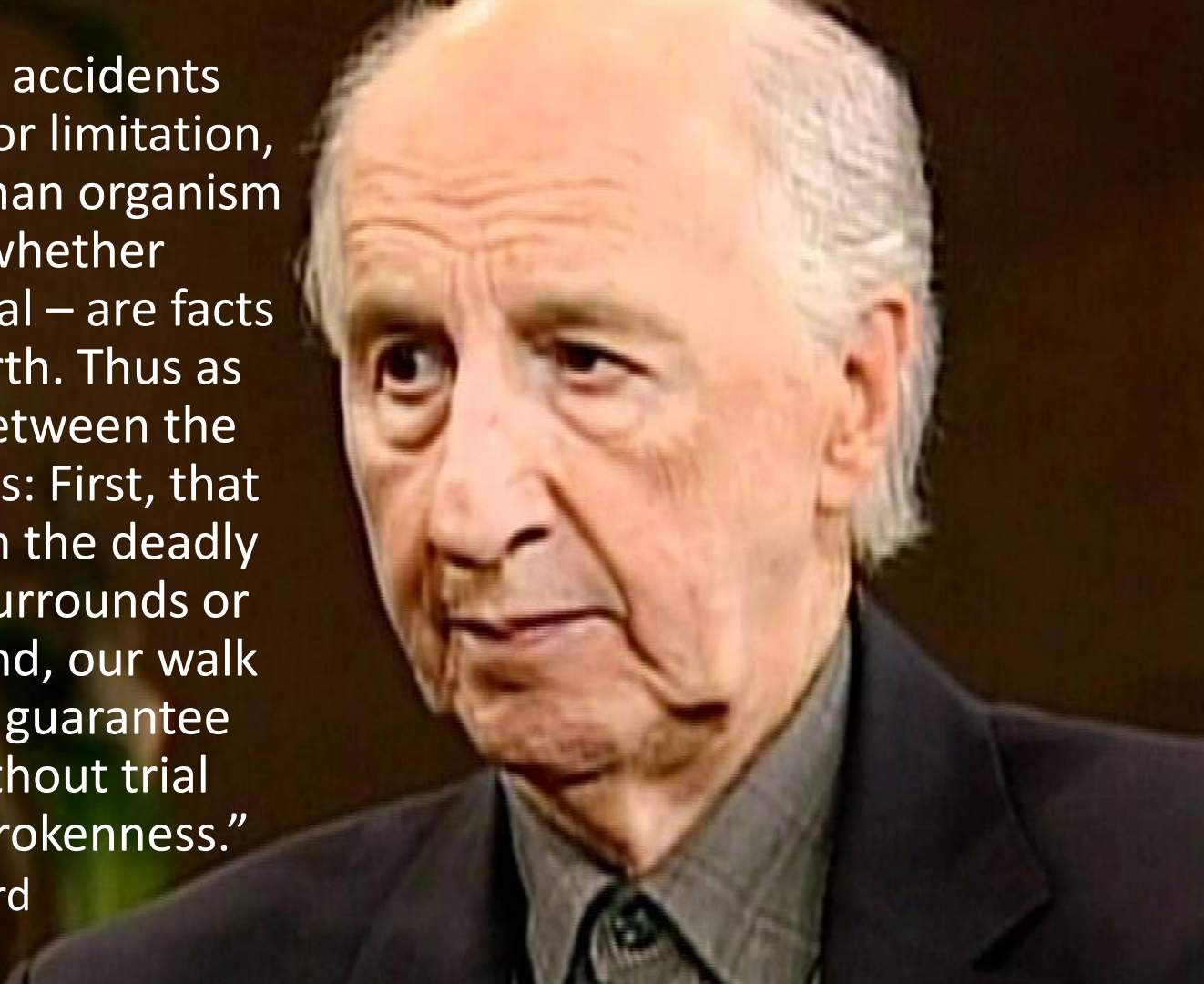
From a personal perspective,
