Be subject therefore unto God; but resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7 ASV literally to stand against; to take a firm stand against an opponent

Be sober-minded, be alert. Your adversary the devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour. ⁹ Resist him, firm in the faith.... 1 Peter 5:8-9a CSB

For this reason take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand. Ephesians 6:13 CSB

Ephesians 6 gives practical instruction for how to live in and from God's kingdom. The kingdom of God is righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Spirit. Character can also erode in the absence of ongoing abiding.

As I continue abiding in Christ in an ongoing situation or challenge, responding consistently in the grace and wisdom he provides, his influence gradually permeates and forms my character. Matthew 10:7-8 CSB "As you go, proclaim, 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.' ⁸ Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse those with leprosy, drive out demons. Freely you received, freely give."
