2 Kings 3:26-27 CSB When the king of Moab saw that the battle was too fierce for him, he took seven hundred swordsmen with him to try to break through to the king of Edom, but they could not do it. ²⁷ So he took his firstborn son, who was to become king in his place, and offered him as a burnt offering on the city wall. the High Priest would sacrifice a young bull for his sins the sins of his family one of a pair of goats would be sacrificed as a sin offering for the people blood from both the bull and goat would be sprinkled on the mercy seat

the High Priest would lay hands on the second goat, confessing the sins of the people

a man would then lead the second goat into the wilderness and release it there two rams would be sacrificed as burnt offerings, one for the High Priest, the other for the people For the life of a creature is in the blood, and I have appointed it to you to make atonement on the altar for your lives, since it is the lifeblood that makes atonement. Leviticus 17:11 CSB ...it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. Hebrews 10:4 CSB

But now he has appeared one time, at the end of the ages, for the removal of sin by the sacrifice of himself. Hebrews 9:26b CSB
