"Let the well that's deep within you spring forth with joy."

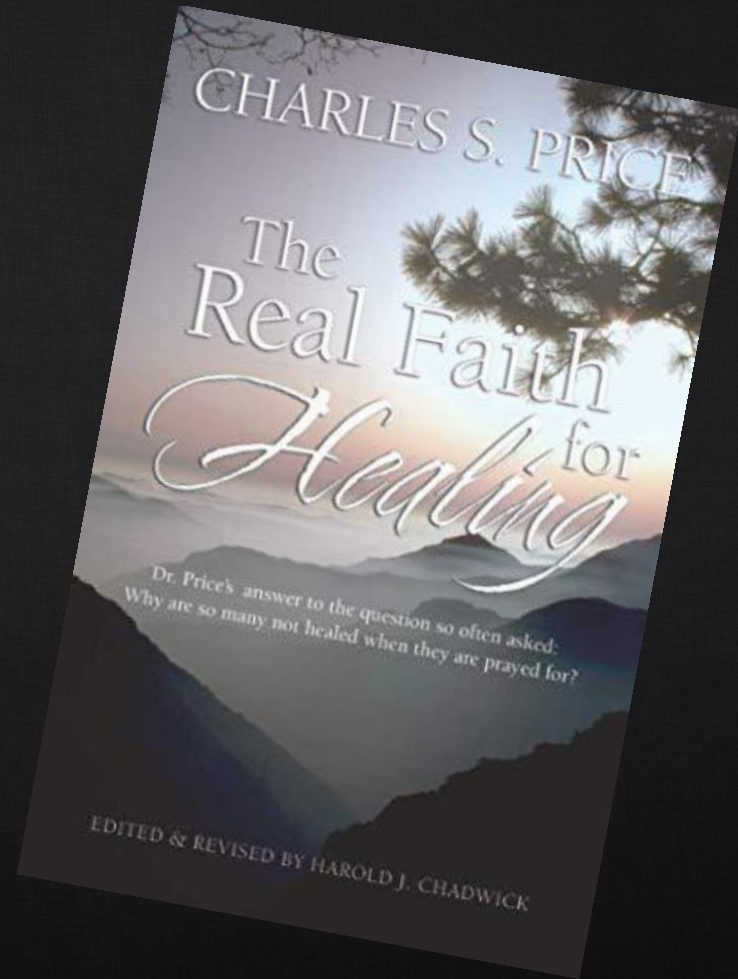
*April 25*


