Exodus 17:11-13, 15 LEB

And when Moses raised his hand, Israel would prevail, but when he rested his hand, Amalek would prevail. <sup>12</sup> But the hands of Moses *were* heavy, and they took a stone and placed it under him, and he sat on it; Aaron and Hur supported his hands, *one on each side*, and his hands *were* steady until *sundown*. <sup>13</sup> And Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with *the edge of the sword*....

Then David said to the Philistine, “You *are* coming to me with a sword and with a spear and with a javelin, but I am coming to you in the name of Yahweh of hosts, the God of the battle lines of Israel, whom you have defied!
