is found in the Old Testament 5410 times.

it is used in connection with another word (or words), revealing a specific aspect of God's character.



#### Exodus 17:11-13, 15 LEB

And when Moses raised his hand, Israel would prevail, but when he rested his hand, Amalek would prevail. <sup>12</sup> But the hands of Moses *were* heavy, and they took a stone and placed it under him, and he sat on it; Aaron and Hur supported his hands, *one on each side*, and his hands *were* steady until *sundown*. <sup>13</sup> And Joshua defeated Amalek and his people with *the edge of the sword*....

#### Exodus 15:23-25a CSB
