
## wisdom

“the ability to use your knowledge and experience to make good decisions and judgments”  
*Cambridge*

“For the sons of this world are wiser in their own generation than the sons of light.”

There is wisdom that has its source in the Spirit and is characterized by ‘meekness’.

There is “worldly, unspiritual and demonic” wisdom that is characterized by “envy and self-seeking.”

In Classical Greek *praus* was used to describe a war horse that had been trained to obey instantly and absolutely, no matter how great the confusion of battle.

*Praus* described a powerful, thousand pound animal that had been conditioned to respond to the slightest touch.

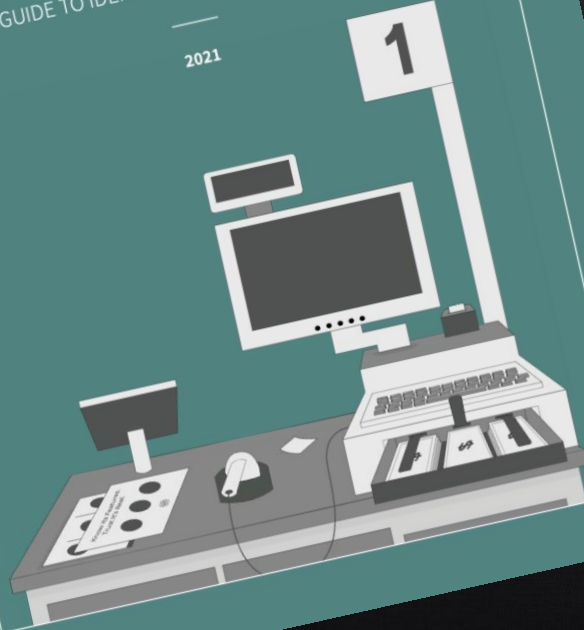
