The blood of the cross professes
God's invitation of love to all who are separated from life in him...

They are disconnected
from God's life because of
their ignorance and their closed
hearts. ¹⁹ They are people who lack
all sense of right and wrong, and
who have turned themselves over
to doing whatever feels good....

his own love for
us in that while we
were still sinners,
Christ died for us.

For while we were still helpless, at the right time,
Christ died for the ungodly.

⁷ For rarely will someone die for a just person—
though for a good person perhaps someone might even dare to die.

⁸ But God proves his own love for us in that
while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

⁹ **How much more then,
since we have now been justified by his blood,
will we be saved through him from wrath.**

The blood of the cross declares
that God's wrath against the rebellion of man's sin has been satisfied...

Formerly, we all
**lived among them in the
passions of our sinful flesh,
as we carried out the desires
of the sinful flesh and its
thoughts.** Like all the others,
we were by nature objects
of God's wrath.

Ephesians 2:3 EHV

...he will exercise vengeance
in flaming fire on those who
do not know God and on those
who do not obey the gospel of
our Lord Jesus. ⁹ Such people will
receive **a just penalty: eternal
destruction away from the
presence of the Lord..**

our old self was crucified
with him so that the body
ruled by sin might be rendered
powerless **so that we may no
longer be enslaved to sin....**
